

Tri-Fold Pyramid Card Tutorial



1. Print out kit on good quality cardstock.

2. Cut out all pieces. Score panels A, B, and C. Cut slit in panel C.



3. Fold panels A, B and C and crease with a bone folder.



4. Starting with panels C and B, glue following diagram included with kit. Finishing with panel A.





5. Add any included 3-D elements and any other decoration you wish.



Cards fold flat for easy mailing.



The kits with Tea Bag tiles are made in the same manner except for one thing. They are printed out on Good Quality Text Weight Paper. Roughly cut the panels out and glue them to a sheet of heavier cardstock. Cut out the panels and assemble as directed above. For the Tea Bag tiles, don't be afraid to try out some new folds. There are many available on the Craft Forum under Card Tutorials and online.

TIP: Some Folds are larger than others. Be sure when placing your medallion doesn't make it too large to fit in your envelope.
