

Pop-out butterfly card

You will need ;-

A plain sheet of A4 card in either white or a matching colour for your design.

Strong all purpose adhesive

Glue stick or paper glue

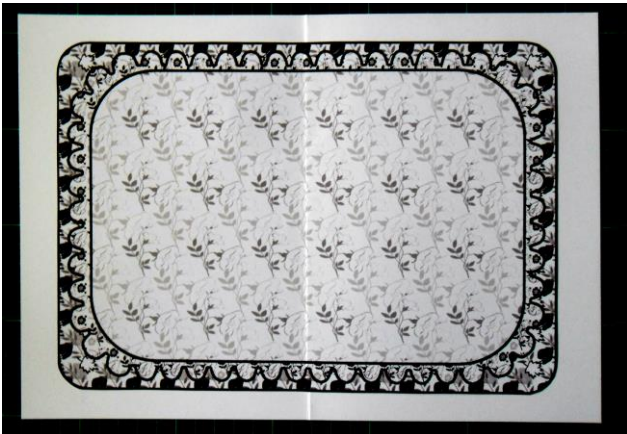
sticky foam pads or silicone glue

In these kits you will find more pieces than you need, this is so you can design the front of the card yourself and change it if you want to make a different one next time. There are also sheets of backing paper which have been used in the kit so you can use them for layering and matting if you choose to.

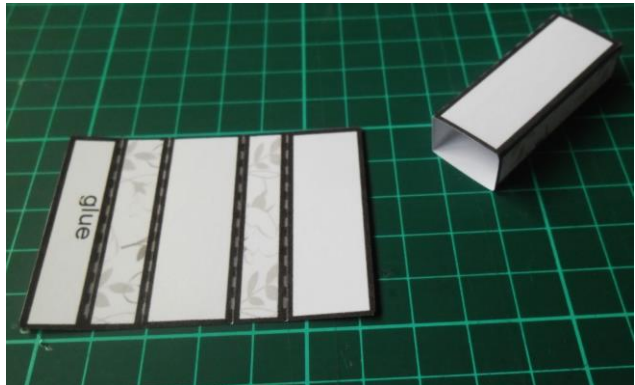
1. Print your sheets onto good quality photo paper or white card. Black and dark colours are best printed onto card as they will not smudge.
2. Cut out the pieces you have decided to use.
3. Fold an A4 piece of card in half.

Also fold the card middle in half and stick it inside the folded piece of A4 card using glue stick or paper glue. See picture 1.

4. See picture 2. Score along the dotted lines on the two supports, fold them into boxes and glue using a strong all purpose adhesive.

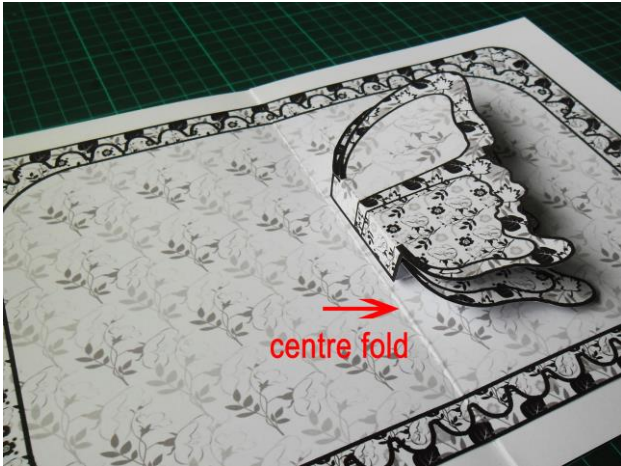

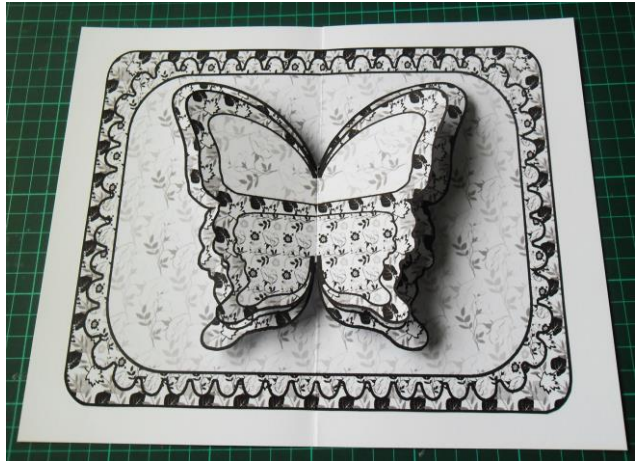

5. Score along the lines on the butterfly flaps and fold them.
6. Stick the supports underneath of the large butterflies using strong all purpose glue. See picture 3
7. Stick the smaller butterfly over the top using strong glue. See picture 4. There will be a space in between the lower and upper butterfly wings.

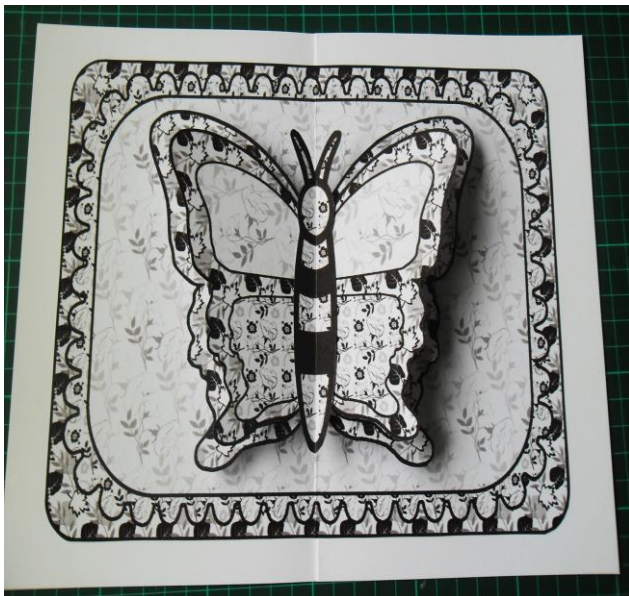

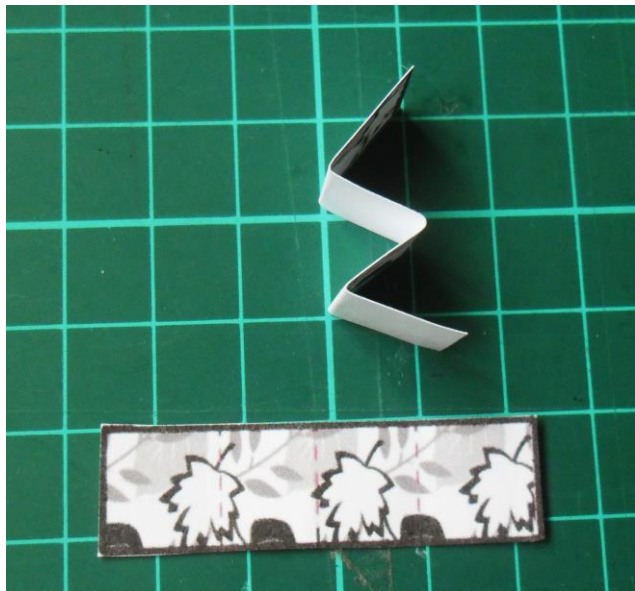

8. See picture 5 – stick the support underneath the butterfly to the card middle right next to the fold in a central position. Do the same with the other side of the butterfly – see picture 6. Also put glue in the centre of the two sides of the butterfly so they stick together.

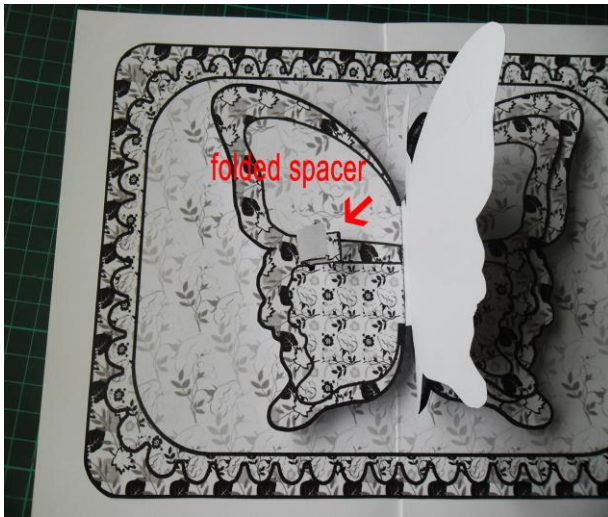

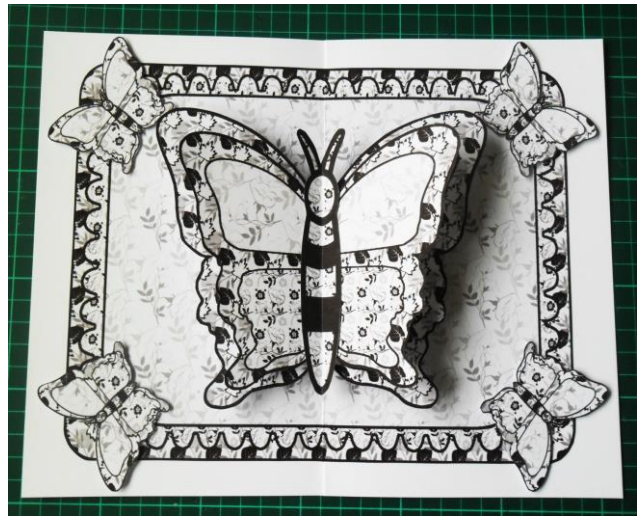

9. See picture 7 – stick the body of the butterfly in place. Check first where you need to put the glue, it only needs to be on the middle section of the butterfly body.
10. See picture 8 – score and fold the spacers. These need to be stuck in between the lower and upper wings so that the cut edges are facing the centre fold of the card. See picture 9

11. See picture 10 – Stick the 4 small butterflies into the corners of the card middle.

12. To make the bow. See picture 11 Put the bow face down and fold the ends into the middle and glue in place.

13. See picture 12 wrap Tab C around the middle and glue in place. Also glue the back ribbon in place. See picture 13
