Lattice Heart Card Instructions



- 1. Print all sheets. I used 210gsm matte photo card stock.
- 2. Print a 2nd copy of the card back (I used plain paper).
- 3. Cut out the paper strips as solid blocks.



4. Attach the blocks of strips back to back.



- 5. Cut up the strips. I only used 5 but there are extra in case you need them.
- 6. Glue the heart pieces back to back but leave 1cm at the spine unglued.



7. Glue the back pieces back to back.



- 8. Cut the right hand flap off the card back.
- 9. Insert the left flap between the front spine pieces. Glue together.



10. Score and fold down the spine.



11. I didn't worry about trimming as the heart edges will be covered with flowers.

- 12. Start by attaching one strip diagonally across the middle of the heart. Trim so that each end lies somewhere in the plain band of the heart.
- 13. Attach further strips in parallel until the heart is filled. I chose to make the gap the same width as the strips.

14. Start the first strip for the opposite direction in the middle of the other side of the heart. Make sure it is at right angles to the first set of strips.



15. Continue until the heart looks like this.



- 16. Attach the floral heart on top, covering the strips. The card is 7" square if you want to keep it within that size, then make sure your flowers stay within the edges of the square card.
- 17. Layer up the flowers. Note that with this particular design I have cut some of the flower groups smaller (cut away edge flowers) so that I could use these smaller pieces as upper layers. Attach greeting and any other decoupage.
- 18. Check the inside. If your foam tape has gone beyond the edge of the heart on the inside you will need to trim it away.



Card is 7" square. I have sprinkled a few rhinestones amongst the flowers and added glitter to the butterflies.
