reverse of sheets 5 & 6 for a pretty lining to your envelope




Before Cutting out score the 3 score lines on the back of your card (sheet 2). Also score the line where marked on the front of the card (sheet 1) Cut out all pieces



Turn over the back of the card. Fold and crease up on the first score line



Fold and crease down on the second score line





Fold and crease up on the third score line to create the W shaped base to your card above. This will be your glue tab. Add double sided tape where shown in blue on the photo. Fold and crease the score line on the card front too



Punch the holes where shown on the front of the card and the wheel



Attach the two pieces together using a small brad. Open out the prongs but leave some wiggle room to allow your wheel to turn freely. Add dst where shown in blue on the photo



Before doing anything else check that your wheel turns freely. If you've left some wiggle room when you added the brad you should have no problems.



Take the front cover of the card and pierce the 4 corners of the window with a needle tool. Then using a craft knife and a ruler locate your knife in one of the pierced holes and cut to another. In this way cut out and remove the small square of card.









Add dimensional tape to the outside of the wheel, making sure you only put it in the corners out of the way of the wheel but within the faint thin line.

Attach the back and front of the card together using the double sided tape you added earlier. Attaching the bottom of the card front to the small glue tab on the card back and attach the top of the card front to the larger glue tab on the back of the card front

Your card will now look like this from the side

Take the front cover of the card and add on top of the wheel attaching it to the dimensional tape you added earlier, centering the design onto the front and aligning with the faint thin line



Turn the wheel to locate the correct number of sleeps in the window



Add the 3D decoupage using dimensionals or silicone









