Rolled Edge Card Instructions

- 1. Print the card cover and insert sheets on 180gsm photo card stock or heavier.
- 2. Print the background papers for the curled layers on plain paper, using the highest print quality setting your printer has. This sheet is slightly larger than normal so that it will cover as close to the edge of the A4 paper as your printer will allow. This is necessary to get maximum match up of printed areas on back and front.



3. Turn the half and half backing sheet over and print the same on the back. Turn the paper when feeding it back into the printer so that you get the opposite pattern on the back of each half. Please refer to the video tutorial. Don't worry if you get this wrong – the end result will only be slightly different to my card.



4. Print an extra copy of the insert so that you can cover both sides of the inside.



5. Score down the centre of the card cover and fold.



6. Attach the insert panels inside the cover.



7. With your double-sided backing paper, cut one piece to 8cm x 16.7cm and the other piece to 10cm x 16.7cm.



8. You are now going to cut a slot across the middle of each piece, approx. two thirds of the way across.



9. To find the middle of each curling layer, simply lay it over the top of the card front and mark as per the middle printed on the card front.



10. Lay the curling papers on the cover, one at a time and curl back the edges to match with the printed image on the cover.



11. Flatten a small area in the middle of the rolled paper only.



12. Roll the paper back a little and put a piece of double sided tape where the curl finishes. Roll back and gently press down on to the tape. Do the same for the other half and then again for the other strip of curling paper. Obviously one piece of paper lines up with the narrower curl image and the other piece lines up with the wider curl image.



13. Attach the wider curled strip to the cover and then the narrower curled strip on top.



14. Attach the ribbon, greeting label and other decoupage layers.



15. I attached the butterflies with PVA under just one wing.

Cards fits in a $5" \times 7"$ (13cm x 18cm) envelope.



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
