

Instructions to make Fancy window gate fold card

1. Print all sheets onto good quality card or photo paper. If you have a lot of dark colours use card as this does not smudge as much as photo paper.
2. Read the instructions BEFORE cutting out the pieces.

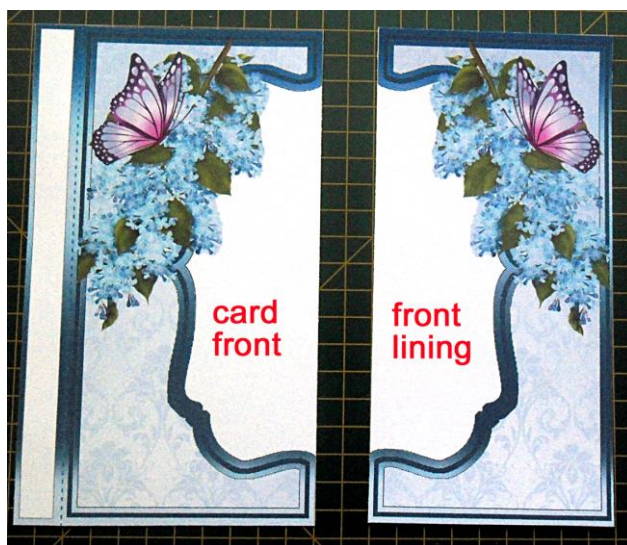

3. Cut out the card fronts and front linings along the temporary cut lines and then around the rest of the shapes
4. Score along the dotted lines near the side flaps on the card fronts (Photo 1)
5. See photo 2 The front lining is a mirror image of the card front. Glue the lining to the back of the card front that it matches. Then when you cut around the fancy shaped front it will fit perfectly. (photo 3). If you cut them out separately and then glue them together the result will not be as good.

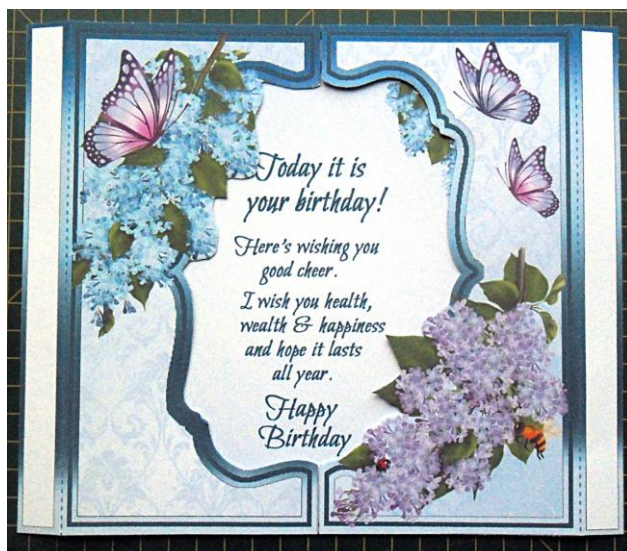

6. Place the two fronts which you have just fitted the linings to over the top of the card middle (photo 4)
7. Fold the flaps backwards so you can stick them to the card back. (Photo 5)

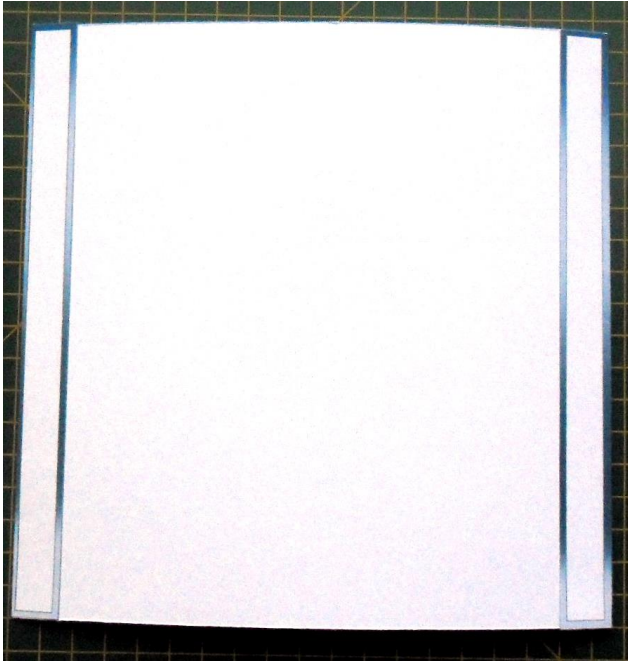

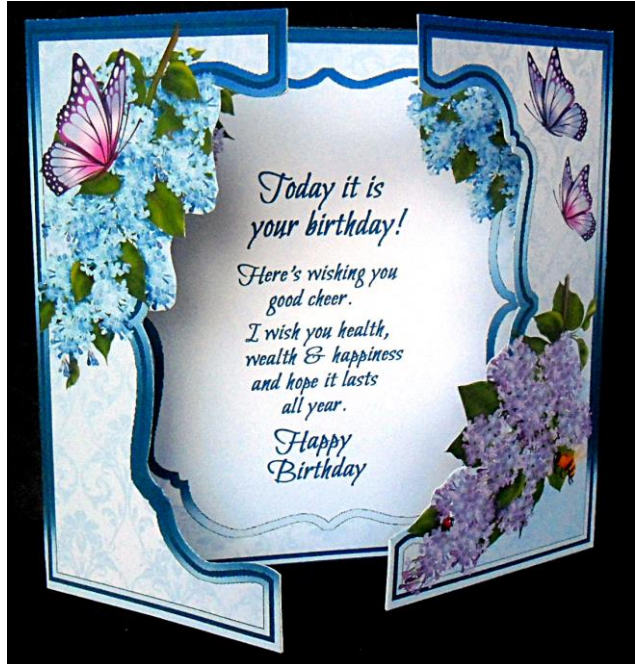

8. Stick on the card back to cover the flaps and make it look tidy.
9. See the finished card (photo 6)
10. Attach any decoupage layers with sticky foam pads or silicone glue. Some kits have decoupage layers, some do not.
11. Add any bling or card candy to make your card look even nicer.
