Fabulous keepsake cards that are simple to make but look so stunning when made up and will WOW the recipient.







Before cutting out score each of the fold lines where marked on the 3 panals, card back and pop out panals.





Also before cutting out extend the cutting lines at the top and bottom of each of the 3 panals to the edge of the cardstock.

Cut out all the pieces, Cutting to the edge of the cardstock of the 3 panals

Cut out, score, fold and crease the pop out panals.



Cut the white folded topvedges of the panals at an angle



When opened out it wil look like this.



Take the back piece of your card and turn over. Fold and crease along each of the the score lines



Add double sided tape to the top where shown at the top

and also on the small folded edge at the bottom



Take the card front, line up and attach the top of the card front to the card back.



Open up, peel back the double sided tape at the bottom, line up the bottoms and stick down.



Attach the largest pop up panal to the bottom of the card with double sided tape. Position it in approx the centre just above the bottom of the card. Add double sided tape to the top of the panal but do not remove the

release paper yet.



Fold and crease the sides of the panals and using double sided tape line up and attach to one side of the card front.



Open up and remove the backing from the double sided tape.



Fold the panal over and making sure the edges are lined up attach to the pop up panal




Remove the backing from the double sided tape on the last flap and lining up the edges stick into place


Add the top 2 of the panals in the same way.

The side of your card will now look like this.





A gentle push on the card front will squish the layers and you card will slip into the matching envelope ready to instantly Pop Out when opened by the recipient!
