## **Handbag Tutorial**

1. Cut out all the pieces in the kit and lay them out carefully.



2. Stick the two pieces of handle together with the flowers on the outside. When dry either glue or use like I have done strong dble sided tape on the bottom edges of both sides



3. Stick this behind panel A which is on the front of the handbag as shown



4. Turn it over and place 2mm foam tape onto the back of this as shown



5. Remove the backing from the foam pieces and attach to the front of the bag as shown



6. The next step is to take the buckle and the gemstone that matches. Place some double sided tape on the first half at the top and a small piece of 2mm foam mount tape on the actual bottom of the buckle on the card as shown



- 7. Take the small gemstone and put a 2mm foam mount on the back and stick it on to the buckle and this will give you a nice 3D effect.
- 8. Now we move onto the flowers. Place a flower with 2mm foam mount on the back onto the flowers on the card. You then place a gemstone onto the middle of the flower on both of them. Another lovely 3D effect. You can see this in the photos.



9. Now we move onto the insert. You will see one is plain and one has an oval in the middle for writing your own message. You put the one with the oval in it on the back inside of the card as shown. I used a soft glue to put this on as shown in the photographs below



10. Now you can place the plain insert into the top of the card with the same glue. You can see this in the photograph.



11. Now we move onto the envelope. Firstly score and fold on the darker edge lines.



12. Place some strong double sided tape to the bottom of the back of the card. Separate the tape and place the front of the card (bottom) onto the tape and it will finish up looking like the photos.



13. You need to place some more strong double sided tape on each side of the envelope as shown in the photograph and then lift off the backing and stick the front to the back. Check the front matches the back exactly before pulling off the tape and if not you can trim the sides accordingly.

I finished my card off by putting some pink gemstones into the flowers but you can put anything you like onto the front of the card.
