## Star Card by SuzieQ Kuttables



This is the finished card, which is 7x7 inches. If you make the base from a lighter cardstock you could interlock the bottom to fold inside the right side. If the cardstock is too stiff it would be difficult to fold the bottom flap in.

This was folded right side first, then the left side, then the bottom which I tucked in behind the right side.



After cutting out the pieces I placed them temporarily where I wanted them so I could see what it would looked like when the card was assembled.



Next I applied score tape to the bottom of each tip. Then I scored the lines and folded them. When you place each tip it is necessary to center it to the center rather than placing it from each tip to tip.



This what the inside looks like when opened up. I had already attached the Happy Birthday label. I closed it up before I attached the label to get the best alignment. You need to be careful to place it so the bottom tip can be folded inside the star.

Fold it right side first, then left side, then bottom and fold it into the star.



This what the back looks like when open.



This is what the back looks like when closed.



I used an exacto knife to cut out the star shape. Score and fold where indicated. I made the score dots very faint so they won't show hardly at all when the envelope is assembled.

I decided to apply the score tape to the front panel, but you can also apply it to the inside flaps of the back piece, which will have the folds on the outside of the envelope.
