

How to make a wiper card


- 1. Print out sheets on to good quality white card.160 gsm was used for this project but any reasonably stiff card will work.
- 2. Cut out all the pieces and score and fold where indicated.

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- 3. Picture 1 shows where to score and fold the card back.4. Picture 2 shows where to score and fold the card front.
- 5. Picture 3 shows where to score the wiper mechanism. Fold this back and forth a few times so that it bends easily.

6. Stick the card front to the card back but only on the left hand side as shown in picture 4

7. Only put the glue where indicated on the wiper mechanism. It is lined up with the fold nearest the card back and slightly down from the top edge (only about 1 or 2 mm). The printed side is facing towrds the card back. see picture 5.

8. Now glue the right hand side of the card front to the card back.

Fix the large front panel and the smal panel on the card front. You can use glue but sticky foam pads will add depth.

10.Flatten the card out so the mechanism pops up.

You can now glue your sentiment on to the wiper, be careful that you do not get glue on to the rest of the card.

 When the card is closed the mechanism should fold down inside the card. As in picture 9

12. The mechanism should pop up when the card is opened. see picture 10.
