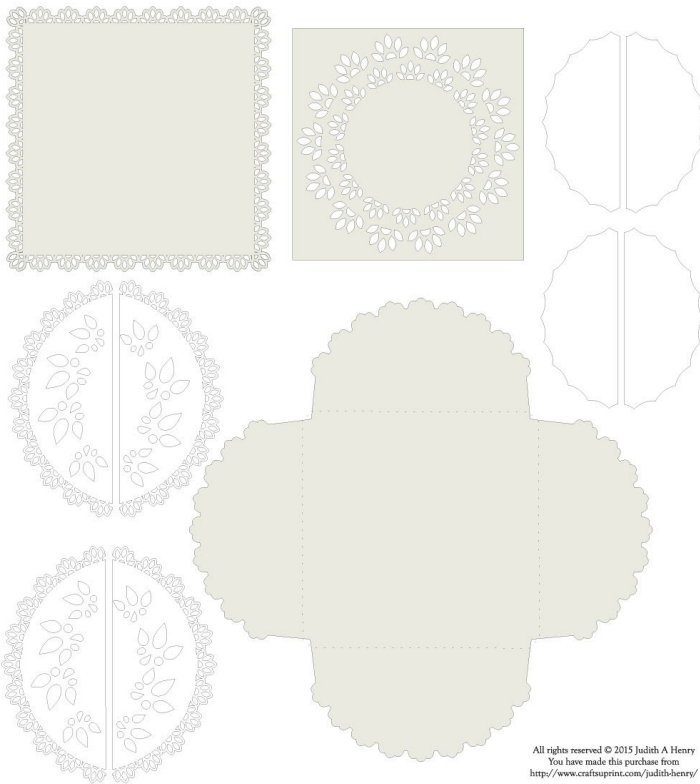


Cutting & Assembly Instructions

Fancy Nested Circular Fold Card



The zip file contains the photo of the completed project along with cutting files. This is the general instructions for several Fancy Nested Folded Card. The cards are very similar to this card.



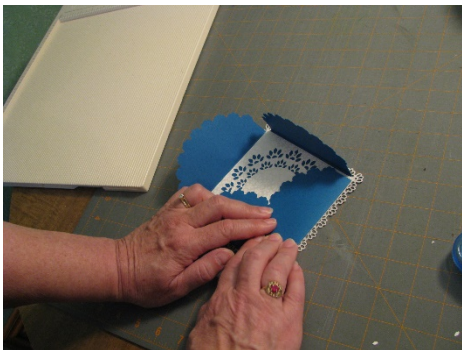
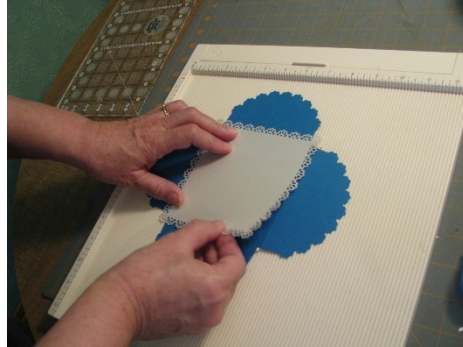
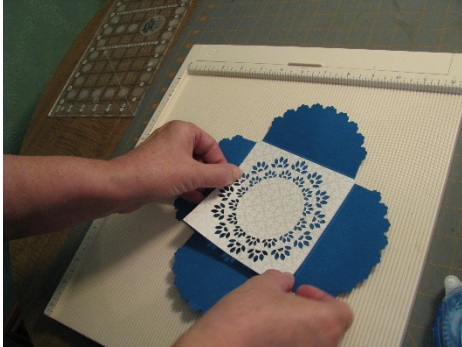
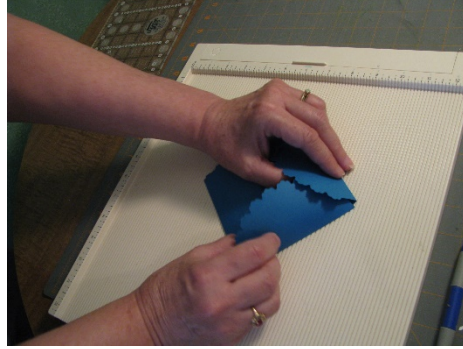
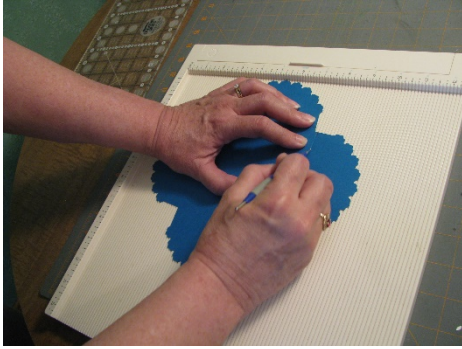
The card is a 4 folded circle card that fits into a 5.5 square inch envelope. A sentiment has not been provided but can be placed on the inside center piece or on the inside side pieces.

The circular flaps nest over each other to hold perhaps a gift card inside.

The card is easily cut if care is taken on the delicate pieces. I have found selecting the correct blade setting for the paper by backing off the speed and thickness while double cutting is the best solution.

Using contrasting paper pops the borders in this card. The main pieces

should be cut with **cardstock**. I chose a solid core blue for the base and pearl floral **cover stock** from the Paper Studio called *Blanc Boutique* for the border pieces. The inside **paper** is a floral print.



The pattern has dotted lines for score marks. I used the silhouettes advance cutting settings to cut at a low thickness to lightly identify where I needed to score the base. After scoring, fold and nest each tab and pressing the fold.

Both center pieces are attached to the inside and outside of the base.

The circle base should fold around the inside piece. When folded the outside base piece should show the lacy edging.

The last piece are the optional inside flaps and the outside fancy lace flaps.

I am particularly proud of this card. It works up so beautiful. An all occasion card yet very elegant for special occasions.
