## TUTORIAL FOR BACK PACK SHAPED CARD KIT

 Cut out all the pieces and lay them out. They are marked from A - G on the separate sheets.



2. Take piece A (card front) and piece B which will be placed onto the main card at the bottom. I used mini foam mounts on the back of the small section and lined up to the top corners of the white piece and stick.






I then used two of the small buckles which are placed onto piece B. I used doubled sided tape on the top half of the buckle and mini foam

mount onto the bottom of the buckle as in the picture above.

3. Take piece F (back of the bag) and cut the small lines on the back so that you can thread through the longer buckles (piece D) and there are two of them. Look at the picture and push each piece through and you can also see from the picture where the buckle part should be. I have kept them flat for posting but if you want to put a bend in the strap then you can. I used double sided tape on the back. See the picture below.







Now take the insert with the white oval frame and place it on the other side of the back (inside of the buckle piece) with soft wet glue or double sided tape. Do the same with the front of the card and the other insert by using a glue to stick them to each other. They should end up looking like the picture below.



4. Take piece G (this part is attached to the top of the front of the card and also on the back of the card which joins them together) and cut the two lines at the top of the piece as this is where the handle will go in and then score on the blue line. Fold it over neatly and then slot in piece E until you get a curve like in my photograph and then glue them to the inside of piece G.

Use some double sided tape or glue to put on piece G onto the main card both front and back.







The first picture above shows the topper that joins the card with the handle placed into it and stuck down inside. It was then placed onto the top of the front of the card at the fold and stuck down and then you can see the back of the back of the card with it stuck down the other side. There is one buckle left (piece C) which can now be attached to piece G the same way as at the bottom of the front part of the card. There is a birthday greeting which you can put on anywhere you wish or a blank one for your own message. Here is a final picture of the finished card.



When I join a card of any sort at the top I tend to place a small piece of narrow strong double sided tape right at the top of the card and this seems to make the card stand up much better as it has glued the front to the back so it doesnt slip down and end up lying flat!!!!. This is a personal choice though.
