

90 degree Popup Card

Cutting & Assembly Instructions for the

2024 Popup card collection



The card used in this tutorial in the Valentine 2024 Triple heart Popup. It has a multi layer popup which is common in most 90 degree popupcards. There are others instruction in my shop tutorials that might help with specific cards.

All of the 90 degree popup cards for 2024 will follow this new tutorial on how to assemble the card. These cards will be standardized to fit a standard A7 envelope. This means the covers for the Valentine 2024 Popup 1 can be used with other 2024 - 90 degree popup cards. For example, the card above has two love birds on the cover. This design could be used for an anniversary, bridal shower or a wedding using my 90 degree popup card designs.

My card designs are for personal use. The cards you make can be sold as a finished product. The design template is copyrighted. They cannot be used to create a template designs for sale. All graphics are copyrighted by the credited artist in the Graphic Credits section of the product listing.

The following is a step by step pictorial tutorial on how to fold and assemble a 90 degree popup card. The principles in the tutorial can be applied to other popup cards in my shop.

Materials used:

12 x 12 red cardstock for the cover

5 x 6 background paper for cover cutout backing

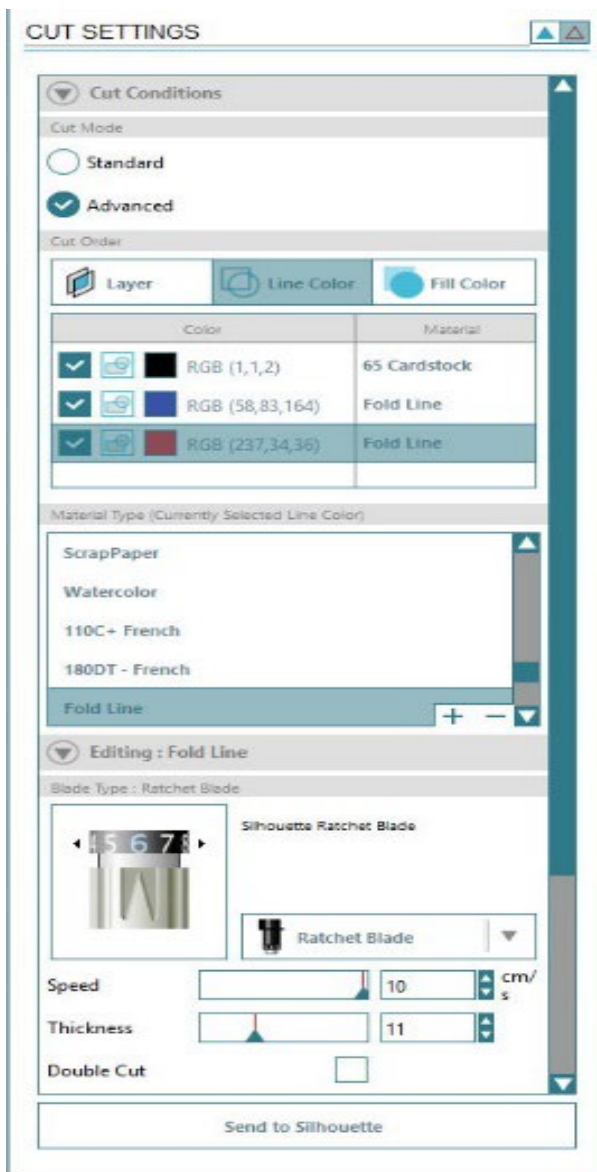
12 x 12 white cardstock for the popup base

Miscellaneous colored cardstock for embellishments

4.25 x 5.5 card for cover (4.25 x 11 inch unfolded)

Adhesive

Patience!!!



Step 1 – Cut the Base card with your machine. Use the colored lines to set up the machine setting. The example uses the Silhouette Cameo.

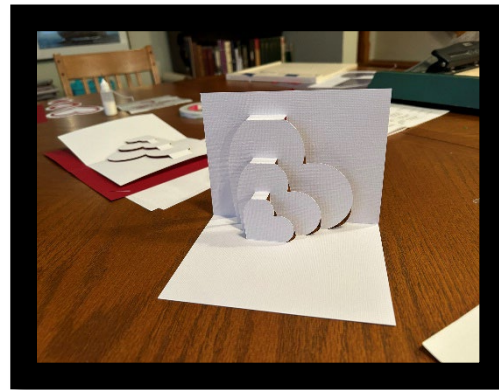
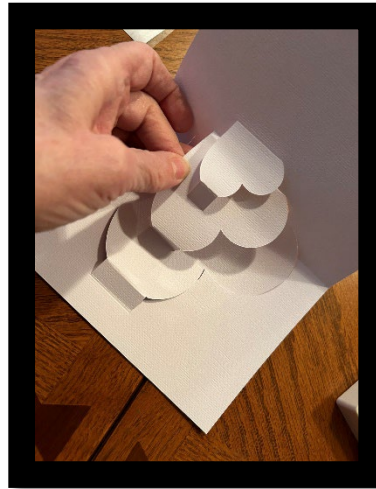
Black lines = cut line

Red & Blue lines = Scoring lines

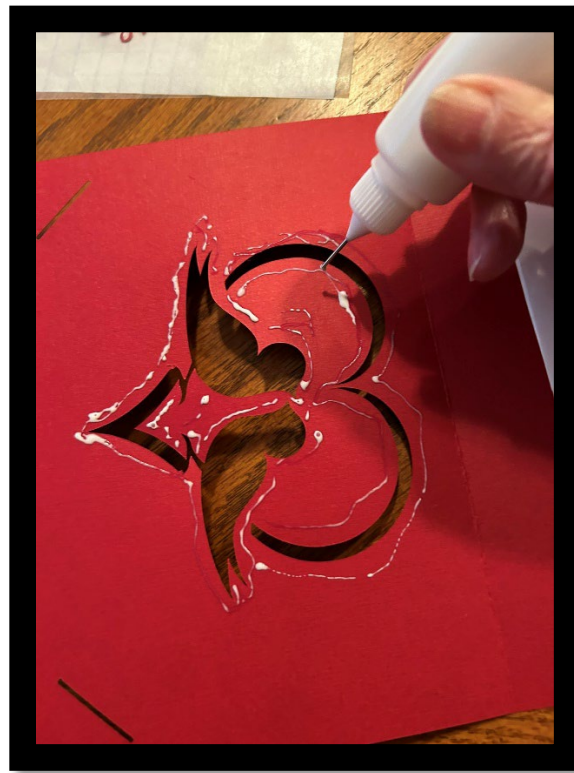
Red = Valley

Blue = Mountain

Using a stylus on a scoring board, score the dotted score lines. Then crease the score line in the direction depending on the color coding. This piece should fold flat when all the lines have been folded and pressed with a scoring bone.

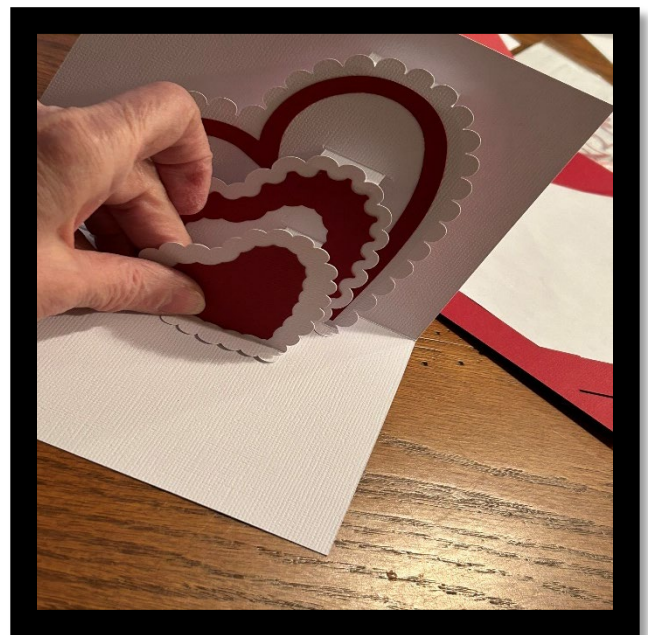


The card's cover has a silhouette cutting. Glue a small piece of paper to cover the opening in a contrasting color. Now fold in half.



The cover has diagonal corner slots. Insert the popup piece by sliding the 4 corners into the slots.

The card's hearts can be embellished with the three decorative hearts provided. The edge of the decorative hearts has a fold which goes against the fold line of the corresponding popup heart. The T slit is provided so the heart can be glued to the matching popup element. There is also red heart embellishments to decorate each heart's edge.



Included in the kit is a sentiment and a decorative cutout. These can be cut from cardstock as shown or vinyl. The application is the same. Using clear transfer lining makes it easy to position the graphics. Add glue to the back of cardstock and position. The smaller graphic can go above the hearts as shown in the finished picture.
