Spring Card with Aperture Gift Box Instructions


Print out out all of the pages in the kit. For best results I use photograph card for all pages except the envelope front and back.



Cut out the spring card base and score along the lines before making the folds as shown below. I find it easier to attach the decoupage layers before sticking the white triangle to the bottom of the card.




Here is the card with all of the decoupage layers in place, stuck down using 3D foam pads. Now that this is done, the glue or DST can be applied to the white triangle and then stuck to the bottom of the card as shown in the 2^{nd} picture below.






Once the card has been completed, the envelope is assembled using a glue stick of DST applied to the flaps on the envelope back.



For the box, you will need to cut out the basic shape, leaving the aperture section in place until you have done all the scoring and folding then cut out the aperture and attach a small section of accetate to the inside of the box lid and crease in the folds. When sticking the sides together, I find that it's easier to start with the flaps that make up the sides of the lid. When sticking, make sure that the smaller sections are on the inside of the box.





When all is complete, your kit should look like this...
