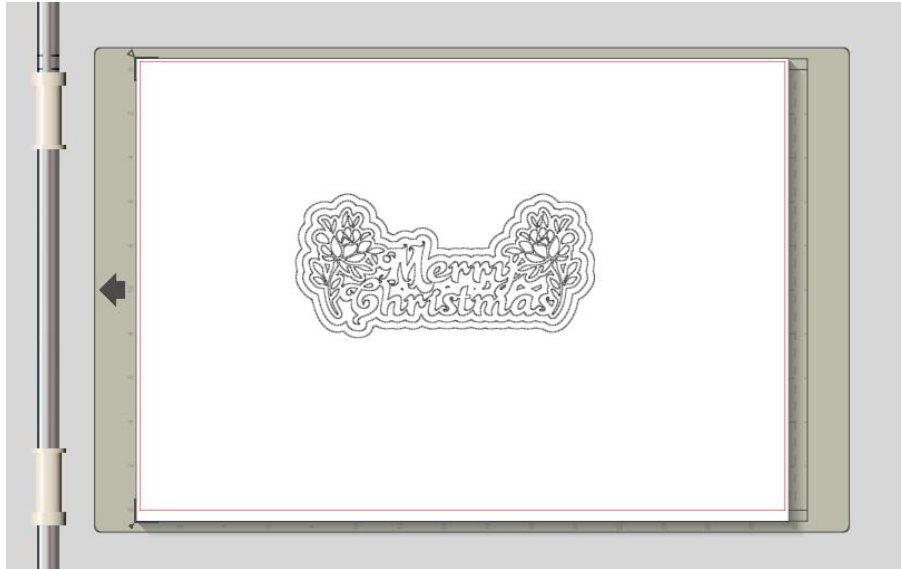
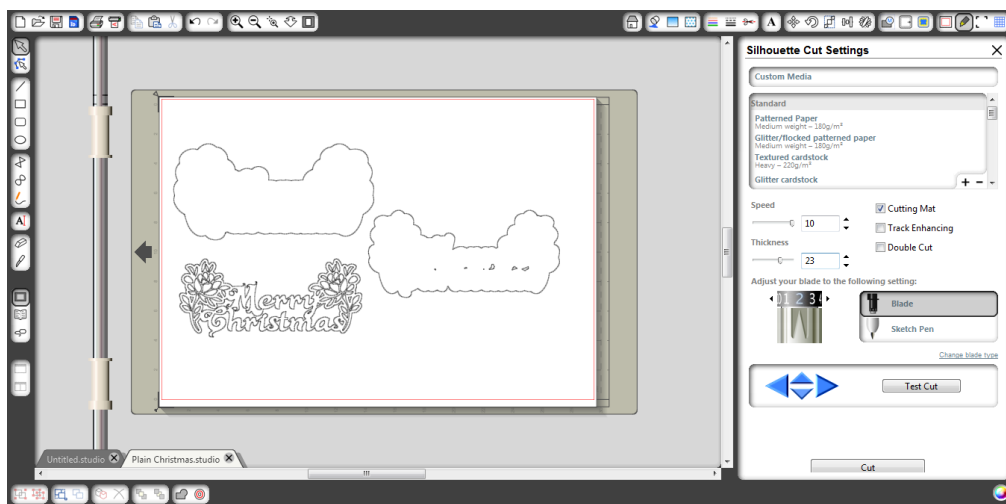


Family Rose Toppers

Instructions



When you first open the file you will find that the layers are all together. You will need to separate them before you cut. To do this simply click on the layer you wish to move and drag with your mouse. (Any layer you do not wish to cut should be moved off the working area).



Once you have separated the layers you are ready to cut. It is best to cut more intricate designs (such as the top layer) with a card weight of 250gsm or less. The thickness setting and blade depth you use will be dependent on the weight and type of card you use.

The best speed for intricate designs is 8-10. (The faster the speed, the less likely it is that you will have tearing).



Once you have cut all of the layers in your desired colours you can begin to construct your topper.



Glue the top layer onto the middle layer (The most popular ways of doing this seem to be: tiny spots of PVA glue, spray glue, glue pen and glue stick).



To complete your topper simply layer your first 2 layers to the bottom layer using foam pads.
