
Instructions to make a side stepper calendar

Print out the main sheets to make the kit onto photo paper or if there is a lot of dark ink use good quality white card as this does not smudge. Fig1






After cutting out the main sheet score along lines A B C & D

Look at Fig 2. Use a craft knife to cut along the line marked x to y

Lines A B & D are mountain folds and line C is a valley fold.





Fig 3 shows how to fold the card.

Fig 4 shows the back of the calendar support and where to put the sticky foam pads. These are easy to cut up as long as the protective coatings are left in place before cutting, otherwise they make your scissors sticky.

Fig 5 shows where to fit the calendar support. The calendar fits behind this so DO NOT stick it down all the way around, see Fig 4 for where to put the sticky pads.

The large decoupage piece is fitted at this stage. These are made of layers which fit on top of each other, match the design on the underneath layer and fix in place with sticky foam pads.

Fig 6 Cut out the calendar pieces but DO NOT cut down the middle. Score and fold down the middle and glue together.

To finish off the card insert the calendar behind the calendar support, stick on the year label and apply any remaining decoupage pieces.
