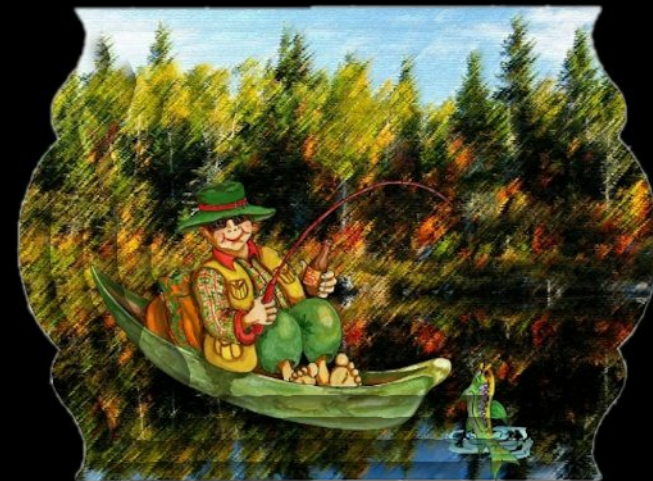


A Quiet Place

Bow Window Card Kit



Pyramage Scene

Insert Assorted Sentiments &
Matching Envelope included

Folds flat to fit in matching Envelope

Bow Window Card

Instructions

Please read through the instructions carefully, before commencing your project

Note the kits may include either Decoupage or Pyramage but the instructions remain the same.

You will also require a piece of acetate measuring approximately 11cm x 10.5cm

After printing out sheet 1, print sheet 3 (backing paper) on the reverse side. This is purely optional but does give a nice look inside the card.

Cut out the main card, score the centre fold and cut out the slits.



Cut out the Bow Window and the aperture. Score and fold the tabs. Glue the ready cut to size piece of acetate on the reverse.



Cut out the Decoupage/Pyramage, using 3D foam pads stick in place.



Next push the top tab through the top slit, fold down and glue this tab in place.



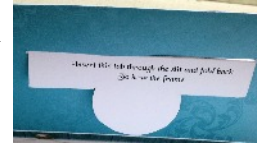
Cut out the insert and fold in half, apply double sided tape to the both sides of the insert and stick in place. The top part of the insert will hide the tab.

To create the Bow Window, insert the bottom tab of the Bow Window into the bottom slot and fold the tab back to keep in place.



To lie the window flat to fit into the envelope, simply push the tab part way back through the slit so it folds over the sentiment, and lies flat. The semi-circle part of the tab remains pushed through the slit on the other side.

To display the card pull on semi-circle and the window will bow.



ENVELOPE



Cut out the front and back of the envelope. Score and fold the tabs and the flaps. Apply glue to the two side tabs and glue the front in place.



Apply more glue to the bottom flap and glue over the envelope front.

Envelope complete.
