
Woolly Hats Easel Card Mini Kits Instructions

These instructions are for the Christmas Hats and the Football Hats which are made in exactly the same way.

Print the 2 sheets onto medium to heavy weight card or photo paper. Cut out all pieces



This step is optional. To make a more sturdy base, print and cut out the easel base a second time to make an underside. Cut off along the top fold line. Matching the front and side edges, attach to the underside of the easel base. This fits the base and the back part of the easel as far as the fold.

Fold the card over to make the easel shape.

Alternatively, use a toning coloured card to reinforce the base.

Attach the card front (the hat) to the folded-over front of the easel, matching the bottom edges and making sure only the lower part of the hat is attached to the easel.

Starting from the largest piece and building up to the smallest, attach the decoupage to the card front, matching the design.

Using sticky pads or silicone glue for depth, attach the stopper / sentiment tag centrally to the base of the card. This will stop the front of the card from slipping forward and allow it to stand up.

Tip - as an alternative to the decoupaged bobble, use a purchased pom-pom or make one yourself using scraps of wool.
