

# Box Frame Card & Presentation Box

## Instructions

Please ensure you read through the instructions before commencing your project.

Start with the Box frame, score and fold all the lines. Cut into the corners to form small tabs. Cut out the centre.



Front View

Glue the tabs to form a boxed frame as shown



Back View

Take the main picture and from the back place it face down inside the frame.

Apply glue to the inside of all the tabs, turn the frame over so the main picture falls back onto the glued tabs.

Press down firmly to secure in place.



Back View

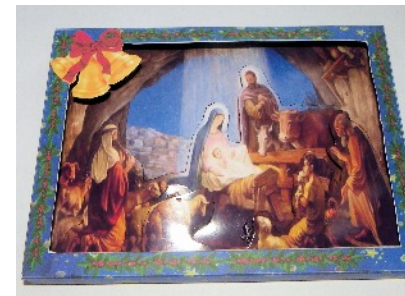
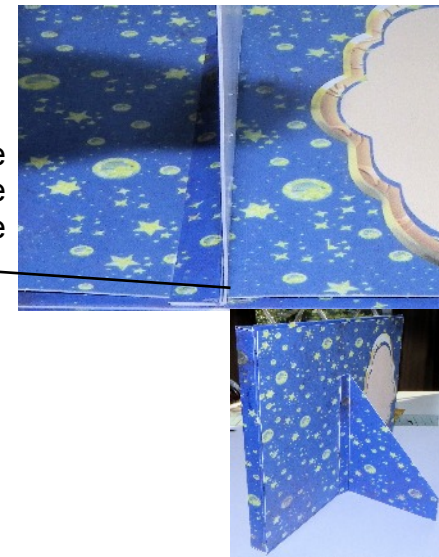
Glue the back of the frame over the tabs to neaten. Note the back piece has a sentiment area. This always goes to the right hand side.



Score and fold the tab on the stand.

Apply glue to the tab.

Notice bottom centre of the back piece there is a small white line. This is the guide as to where to place the folded edge of the tab.



Turn the card back over, and stick the easy decoupage pieces in place. (The outlines are a guide, you can cut into the pieces more if desired). It is recommended that silicone glue is used as it is easier to slide the pieces into place.

*(The easy decoupage has a border around which makes it easier to cutout. However if you wish you can also cut more intricately around the characters.)*

All that is left is to add a sentiment and the card is complete.

## Presentation Box

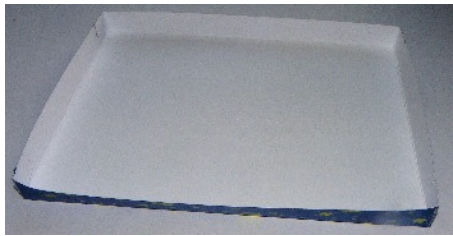
Please note the base and the lid are assembled in exactly the same way.

Score and fold the sides and the tabs. Cut little notches in the tabs.



Apply glue to the tabs and stick together. (Use wet glue)

Repeat for the lid.



Presentation Box Complete.



## Getting the most from your kit.

Included in the kit is a bonus pyramage sheet. You can easily make a complete card from this kit.

- Cut a folded piece of card the same size as the Box Frame Back.
- Print the Presentation Box Base onto paper, cut of the sides and trim to use on the card as a backing paper.
- Cut the sides off the main frame and use as a border on your card.
- Layer up the pyramage on the card front.
- Use the embellishments as extra decoration.
- If you dont want to use the pyramage use the Main Scene and easy decoupage.
- Cut out the decoration on the box lid and use as extra decoration if desired.
- Print the Box Frame Back onto paper, and fold in half for an insert.
- Print out another Presentation Box onto card and make up as normal.
- You now have a box for your folded card.

*There are probably lots more variations you can think of, so be creative and think outside the 'Frame Box'!*

## Tree Decoration (From the Christmas themed Kits)

- Print off the pyramage sheet twice.
- Layer up both sets.
- Glue back to back
- Punch hole through the centre, and thread through ribbon or cord.

Now you have a decoration for the tree!

*Although the shown photographs are for the Nativity Kit the principle is the same for any of the kits in this range.*
