

Vintage Lady In A Frame 8x8 Decoupage Cards

Instructions

1. To make this card you will need an 8" x 8" card blank and envelope.
2. Print the main design sheet onto high quality medium weight paper or card. Crafty Bob paper works well for this.
3. If you wish you can also purchase and print the matching insert on lighter weight paper.



4. Cut out all the pieces. Small scissors work well for the decoupage layers, a craft knife also works well. I recommend using a metal ruler and crafting knife for cutting out the main image to ensure you get a straight and accurate cut.

5. Use glue or double-sided sticky tape to stick the main image to the card blank.

6. Use sticky foam pads or silicon glue on the back of the decoupage layers and stick them on top of the corresponding part of the main design. Start with the flower cluster and add the other layers after.

7. If you have chosen to print the matching insert, cut this out, again a craft knife and metal ruler work well to ensure you get a straight and accurate cut.

8. I prefer to stick the insert along the inner edge only with thin double sided tape but you can stick it down completely if you prefer.

9. The insert sheet has two smaller versions of the main image, these are perfect for sticking on the back of the card or inside the card opposite the insert. They can also be used used to decorate the envelope or to make matching gift tags. The area where the greeting goes has been left blank on these smaller images, meaning you can use your own greeting or use them to show who the card was hand-made by.

10. Get creative! Add ribbons, bows, glitter or gems to bring this card to life.
