

Instructions to make a 3D box from a Silhouette Cameo cutting file

1. Cut out the pieces you need using 210gsm good quality smooth card. You will need two colours of card, one colour for the shapes with holes and another colour for the outline shapes.

The design used for this demonstration is called "A box of roses".

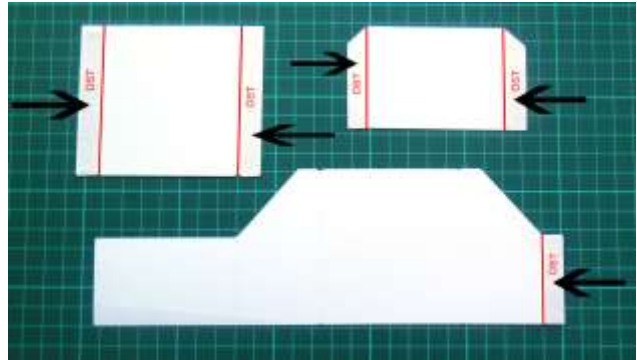

2. Stick double sided sticky tape to the flaps on the pieces to make the box (see fig 2).

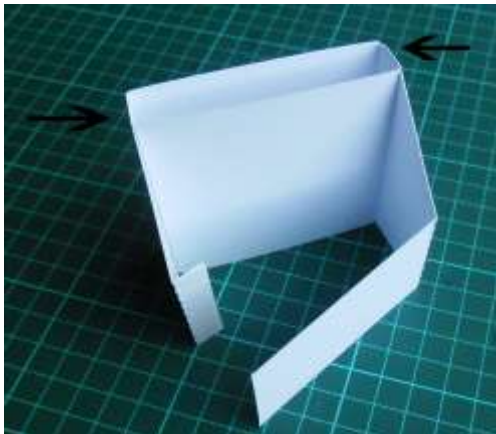

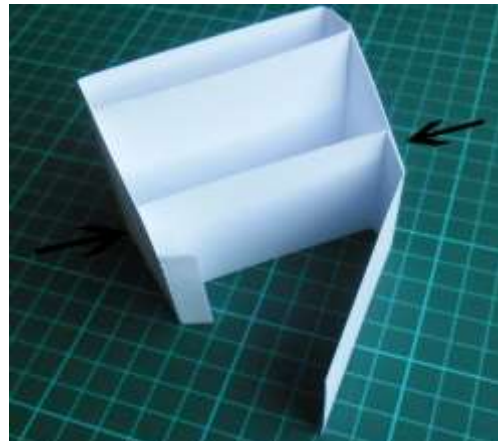

3. Fold the flaps backwards on the large back insert and stick into place so that the flaps touch the back of the box (fig 3).

4. Using the smaller insert fold the flaps forwards and stick inside the box so they are touching the front edge (Fig 4).

5. Close the box front and stick down the flap (fig 5).

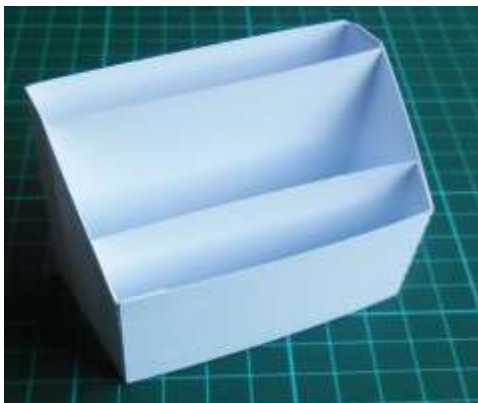

6. Stick the outline shapes onto the back of the shapes with holes. The easiest way is to use a glue stick and dab it on.

7. Use all purpose glue or double sided sticky tape to fix the box into position on the archway shape (fig 7).

8. Use sticky foam pads to attach the sentiment label.

9. The embellishments in all these kits are separate so you can put them where you like. You may need to cut slits in the embellishments to slide them over the sides of the box, see fig 8.

10. Fig 9 shows the finished card.

11. To make the card fold flat push the box sideways, see fig 10.
